

INCLUDE:

- ◆ Gas leaks
- ◆ Broken water pipes
- ◆ Exposed electrical wires
- ◆ No heat (if the outside temperature is 45-degrees or lower)
- ◆ Sewer line stoppage (not drain line)- this includes a clogged toilet
- ◆ CO/Smoke detector beeping or chirping

Also fire, flood, or anything that threatens life, safety or property damage.

Recipe for the Month!

Bacon Cheeseburger Dip

Ingredients:

1lb. Lean ground beef
 1 1/2 cups chopped onions,
 2 medium
 2 cloves garlic, minced
 6 oz. Prairie Farms
 Bacon Cheddar Dip
 8 oz Cheddar cheese, shredded
 2 tbsp ketchup
 2 tbsp sweet pickle relish
 1 tbsp yellow mustard

Directions:

In a large skillet, cook ground beef, onions and garlic over medium-high heat until meat is brown, using a wooden spoon to break up meat as it cooks. Drain off fat. In a 3 1/2-quart or 4-quart slow cooker, combine meat mixture, cheese dip, ketchup, mustard and pickle relish. Cover and cook on low-heat setting for 3 to 4 hours or on high-heat setting for 2 1/2 hours. Serve immediately or keep warm, covered, on warm setting or low-heat setting for up to 2 hours, stirring occasionally. Serve to dip with chips or pretzels or drizzled over potato wedges.
