- Pets are NOT allowed. You may have a fish provided the tank is larger than 20-gallons and it is
  not kept in a carpeted room. Tenants are <u>not</u> allowed to have pet visitors or "pet sit" at their
  homes even for a short period of time. Violations of this policy will lead to eviction.—Tenants
  are not allowed to harbor or feed stray animals.
- Swing sets and trampolines are allowed. You must provide proof of liability insurance of \$100,000 minimum. If you have a swing set or trampoline and Shelbyville Homes does not have proof of insurance, you will be instructed to remove the item until insurance and proof of such is submitted, you will be given an eviction notice. Swing sets and trampolines must be in good repair. Trampolines must have the safety netting and anchored to the ground. If you have proof of liability insurance, please send it into the office.
- Basketball hoops will be allowed provided they are freestanding of the residential structure.
   This mean they cannot be attached to the house or garage and the basketball pole cannot be mounted in the ground. It must be on a stand that is able to be moved. Shelbyville Homes must approve all basketball hoops ahead of time. Anyone wanting a basketball hoop must show proof of Renter's Liability Insurance.
