- * When you receive paperwork from the Housing Authority, please hold onto it. All paperwork contains important information, such as dates things are due, rent amounts, etc. By keeping the paperwork you'll know when, where and how much and will not have to call the housing office for that information.

PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE & HOUSING QUALITY STANDARD INSPECTIONS

*Q&A (Quality Assurance) inspections may take place on work orders and inspections anywhere from 3-5 days after the inspection/work order happened.

<u>SMOKE FREE.</u> These homes are smoke free therefore smoking in not allowed inside the homes for any reason, this includes the attached garage.

When you move be sure to take all your property with you. MHS will not be responsible for articles left on the premises. Any articles left become the property of the Authority and will be disposed of.

No painting (interior or exterior), border trim, or remolding of dwelling unit is allowed.

POST YOUR PET'S ID

All Pet Identification cards must be posted in the front door window of apartments. This lets housing staff know that a pet has been approved and may be inside the unit. In this case staff will be careful to close the door so the pet doesn't get outside. If there is no ID in the window, staff will assume the pet has not been approved and the resident could face reprimand from the office.

If a Pet ID has become faded or is lost, the resident should call the Housing Office so staff can take a new picture and issue a new card.

Only an approved cat or dog is allowed in Gillespie Senior Residences.

Overnight Guests

When reporting overnight guests, please give the person's name. address, the date they arrived, or will arrive, and the date they'll be leaving. Please give your name and address as well.

All overnight guests must be reported to the office. There is a limit per overnight guest of 14 nights in a 12 month period.

To add someone to your lease, request an application from the office. The person you are adding must be APPROVED before he or she may live in the unit.
