pring Cleaning Checklist

- wipe down cabinets inside and out clean out vanity - discard expired items clean & disinfect light switches & fixtures
- clean/disinfect toilet (under lid, around base, hinges) clean shower top to bottom including shower head mop & clean floors - pay extra attention to corners check vanity for unused items - donate or discard
 - replace shower liner and wash curtain
 - organize drawers & cabinets clean and disinfect trash can
 - clean sink and faucet wash or replace bath mats

KITCHEN

- clean and disinfect trash can organize drawers & cabinets
- O deep clean oven, stove top & burners
- clean out pantry (check expiration dates)
- check cabinets & drawers for unused items donate clean fridge - inside & out (don't forget the coils!)
- ☐ clean/sanitize microwave ☐ wipe down cabinets
 - ☐ disinfect light switches and small appliances clean/disinfect light switches & fixtures
 - mop and thoroughly clean floors
 - ☐ disinfect garbage disposal clean coffee maker



LIVING AREAS

- arefully wipe down all electronics clean remotes, phones, game controllers Odust picture frames, wall hangings & mirrors organize media storage - donate unused items vacuum sofas & chairs wash pillows and throws dust shelves, cabinets, furniture - polish if needed □clean lamps and lampshades □ clean ceiling fans
 - disinfect door knobs and light switches
 - clean window sills and window coverings
 - mash windows and window screens wipe down baseboards and moldings
 - malls & cabinets

BEDROOMS

- rotate seasonal clothing
- □ replace bedding □ rotate mattress Clean all surfaces and remove clutter
- Organize closet donate unused items Oclean under bed and organize underbed storage
- pick up and put away all items on closet floor
- Odust picture frames, wall hangings & mirrors
- clean windows, sills, window coverings & screens
 - wipe down baseboards and moldings
