*Q&A (Quality Assurance) inspections may take place on work orders and inspections anywhere from 3-5 days after the inspection/work order happened.

Ingredients:

- 2 cups white chocolate melting candy
- 1/4 cup creamy peanut butter
- Reese's Pieces, mini pretzel twist, and candy corn topping.





Instructions:

- 1. Prepare a nonstick work surface using a silicone mat or parchment paper to be approximately 18 inches x 9 inches.
- 2. Melt the melting candy according to the directions on the package.
- 3. Spread it on the prepared work surface using an angled spatula or knife until it is about 1/8 inch.
- Place the peanut butter in a small zip top bag, pushing it all the way down to one of the corners. Twist the top like a piping bag. Place in the microwave and heat for 15-20 seconds until PB is warm through.
- 5. Snip the corner and pipe the peanut butter in straight lines across the spread white candy. Drag a knife back and forth across the PB lines to create a beautiful marble.
- 6. Sprinkle the Reese's Pieces, mini pretzel twists, and candy corn over the top, slightly pressing into the melted candy if necessary.
- 7. Let candy cool for 10-30 minutes until candy is hardeded. Cut our break into pieces before serving and/or packaging.
- 8. Store in an airtight container for up to 2 weeks.
