Mowing season is here and we want to remind you that you are responsible for your lawn care. We require that it is no longer that 5" in height, but not cut too low to the ground. If we notice that your lawn gets beyond this height you will be sent a notice. If you do not take care of it after the notice, maintenance staff will contract your yard to be mowed at your expense. You MUST store your lawn mower in the garage along with the gas can for your mower. DO NOT store the gas can inside of your home. You are also responsible for keeping your mulched area well maintained and weeded.

Please make sure that your children are playing in their own yards and being considerate and kind to everyone. They need to clean up their toys and trash when they are done playing outside for the day, including the playground.

- ◆ CO/Smoke detector beeping or chirping

How to Clean and Maintain Your Front Loading Wash Machine

Regular Cleaning:

Clean the detergent drawer:

-Remove the drawer and wash it with warm soapy water, then rinse and dry it thoroughly.

Clean the door gasket:

-Wipe down the rubber seal around the door with a cloth soaked in white vinegar, paying attention to the folds where water and residue can accumulate.

Clean the outside of the washer:

-Wipe down the exterior surfaces with a damp cloth and mild dish soap.

Run a cleaning cycle:

-Many front-load washers have a special cleaning cycle designed to remove detergent residue and other buildup. You can find Affresh cleaning tablets at Walmart.

Preventative Measures:

Use high-efficiency (HE) detergent:

-Front-load washers are designed to work with HE detergents, which create less suds and prevent buildup.

Leave the door open:

-After each wash, leave the door open to allow the interior to dry completely and prevent mildew growth.
