Friendly Reminders

⇒ Garbage removal is provided by MHS. Trash should be placed in plastic bags and then placed inside the trash receptacles with the lids securely fastened. Do not leave bags on top of cans. Each home is provided with a garbage receptacle. It is up to the residents to use them and care for them. The resident is responsible for cleaning them regularly. Trash receptacles are to be stored **INSIDE** the garage at all times except on trash day. On collection days, trash receptacles need to be placed near the street for collection. After trash pick-up, trash receptacles need to be immediately removed from the street and placed inside the garage.
