## FROM THE DIRECTOR'S DESK

Summer officially begins this month . Warmer weather means more time spent outdoors. Please remember the following:

- Swimming and wading pools are **NOT** allowed in the developments.
- Clean up after yourself when outside: Toys, trash, clothing, and food. This includes at the playground as well.



You may start seeing these door hangers at your unit this Summer.

These hangers will be used when lease violations are noticed at your apartment.

You are responsible to maintain your lawn. You must not cut it too low to the ground. We require that it be no taller than 5" in height. If beyond this height, we will notify you. If not taken care of after the notice, our maintenance staff will contract your yard to be mowed at your expense.

We expect you to keep all shrubs and plantings trimmed. You are responsible for weeding and maintaining the mulched area.

Trash receptacles are to be stored **INSIDE** the garage at all times except on trash day. On collection days, trash receptacles need to be placed near the street for collection. After trash pickup, trash receptacles need to be immediately removed from the street and placed inside the garage.

- ◆ Gas leaks
- ◆ Broken water pipes
- ◆ Exposed electrical wires
- ◆ No heat (if the outside temperature is 45-degrees or lower)
- ◆ Sewer line stoppage (not drain line)- this includes a clogged toilet
- ◆ CO/Smoke detector beeping or chirping

Also fire, flood, or anything that threatens life, safety or property damage.
