EMERGENCIES

INCLUDE:

- ◆ Gas leaks
- ◆ Broken water pipes
- ◆ Exposed electrical wires
- ◆ No heat (if the outside temperature is 45-degrees or lower)
- ◆ Sewer line stoppage (not drain line)- this includes a clogged toilet
- ◆ CO/Smoke detector beeping or chirping

Also fire, flood, or anything that threatens life, safety or property damage.

Pet Reminder's:

- Visitors are not allowed to bring pets and the residents shall not engage in "pet-Sitting"
- Residents are prohibited from housing any pet, the residents shall apply for a pet permit. If a pet is approved residents shall follow all pet policy rules.
- Permitted Pets are domesticated dogs, cats, birds in cages, fish aquariums, hamsters, guinea pigs, and gerbils. All other animals are specifically excluded.
